

Unload in a timely manner and move your vehicle to one of the exhibitor parking areas as directed. Crating is allowed ringside 15 minutes prior & 15 minutes after scheduled class (PER PURINA FARMS POLICY). These crates must be in a single line through the center of the tent(s). Please remove your crates immediately after judging of your breed. Crates are not allowed on the grass. (however, you may crate temporarily on the sidewalk areas.) See premium for parking info
